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Presentation of Record

This appendix reproduces, entire and in facsimile, every Mālikī-tier source unit pinned by the frozen ḤIBAH doctrine volume, together with the carriers' edition witnesses and the boundary leaves that make each chapter seam visible to the reader. It exists so that no quotation, paraphrase, or pin in the doctrine volume rests on the desk's word: every locus is checkable against the page image here, and every page image is traceable to a hash-pinned constituent in the staging manifest of record (the staging manifest of record).

The volume is issued in **three parts** (see §C.2 — the platform's 100 MiB per-file ceiling, discovered and verified of record on this date, forced the division; the division follows the doctrinal tiers and loses nothing).

- **Reproduced:** the pinned range print 3–39 **entire** (37 pp.; Part 3 pp. 3–39).
- **Boundary of record (render-verified 2026-09-05):** the *ḥiba* chapter opens at print 3 (headword, matn, and margin — Part 3 p. 3) and closes by print 37; **the laḡṡa chapter’s running heads begin at print 37** and its opening content follows. The pinned range’s final pages (print 37–39) are reproduced so the boundary stands visible. **Erratum E-1** to the frozen *ḤIBAH* volume’s certificate corrects its span statement (“print 3–39” → *ḥiba* print 3–~36). Every pin the doctrine volume uses from this witness (definition margin at print 3; *rujūʿ* at print 24) lies inside the true *ḥiba* span — no quotation or pin is affected.

- **Boundary of record (render-verified 2026-09-05):** the chapter headword stands on **print 171** (it appears twice on that page, matn لثواب / تملك بلا عوض (الآخرة); print 170's running head still carries bāb al-waḥf — running-head lag at the chapter turn (Part 3 p. 81 shows the waḥf head exactly so). The laḥṭa chapter's running heads begin at **print 217**; the ḥiba chapter closes by print 216. The pinned range is reproduced entire so both boundaries stand visible. **Erratum E-2** to the frozen ḤIBAH volume's certificate corrects its span statement (“print 170–219” → ḥiba print 171–~216). Every pin the doctrine volume uses from this witness (the definition at print 170–171 as stated) lies at or inside the true span — no quotation or pin is affected.

 - **Reproduced:** print 205–206, 2 pp. (Part 3 pp. 156–157) — i’tiṣār (irjā‘ al-mu‘ī ‘aṭīyyatahu dūna ‘iwāḍ; no retraction right for non-parents per Imām Mālīk).

Chapter 2

§B. Disclosures of Record (Gating Nothing)

1. **Three-part division (platform ceiling).** The volume was planned of record as a single facsimile file, ~565 pp. On this date the delivery mount enforced a **100 MiB per-file ceiling**: the assembled single file (566 pp., 155,680,830 B) failed every write at exactly 104,857,600 bytes (verified with a controlled 95 MiB + 10 MiB append test — the append died at the same byte mark). The volume was therefore issued in three parts at natural doctrinal-tier seams (§1–3 / §4 / §5–10), each part hash-pinned of record (§C.1). No page, divider, or byte of content was dropped, reordered, or recompressed; the three parts concatenate to exactly the planned volume.
2. **Estimate history.** The candidate was described of record as “~280 staged facsimile pages”. The true count at assembly is 556 facsimile pages + 10 dividers = 566 pp. The earlier figure was an estimate of the staged extract page counts only (85+60+25+235 = 405 for the extracts alone, plus container ranges then estimated); it is disclosed here as estimate-history. The candidate J errata park is unaffected.
3. **Black calibration leaves.** The Mudawwana extract of record opens with three black leaves (extract pp. 1–3); they are reproduced entire (Part 1 pp. 2–4), pixel-verified as black in the source itself.
4. **Frozen-register span overruns → errata E-1/E-2.** Render-verification on this date established the true chapter boundaries inside two pinned container ranges (Mawwāq: ḥība print 3–~36, laṭṭa running heads from print 37; Zurqānī: ḥība print 171–~216, headword on 171, laṭṭa running heads from print 217). The frozen ḤİBAH volume’s §A.2 span statements (“print 3–39”; “print 170–219”) describe the *pinned ranges*, which overrun the true chapter spans at the margins. Both are corrected by dated errata E-1/E-2 to the frozen volume’s certificate (2026-09-05); the frozen text itself is untouched. **No pin used by the doctrine volume falls outside the true spans; no quotation is affected.**
5. **Running-head lag.** Zurqānī print 170 carries the bāb al-waqf running head though the chapter headword stands on print 171 — a normal running-head

lag at the chapter turn, reproduced visibly (Part 3 p. 81) and stated on the §7 divider.

6. **Ḥaṭṭāb unit head leaf.** The Ḥaṭṭāb pinned range (print 1–39) begins with the volume-8 title page as bound in the carrier (Part 3 p. 41); the chapter content follows within the pinned range. The boundary was render-verified (new bāb headpiece at print 40).
 7. **Context volumes disclosed, not reproduced.** Kharashī vols. 6 and 8 are staged as context (MD5s of record, §A.8) but carry no pins and are not reproduced.
 8. **OCR discipline.** The Ibn Rajab OCR text layer was used as a search aid only; every pin was verbatim-read on true scans; no OCR text is reproduced anywhere in this volume.
 9. **Writing-tool outage of record.** During assembly the delivery mount dropped twice under sustained write load (kernel resets; Errno 5/107). The build was completed via local staging + throttled resumable copy; on-mount MD5s were re-verified bit-exact against the local builds. No source bytes were at risk at any point (sources verified before and after).

3.2 C.2 Assembly provenance (Phase-D-lite audit of record, 2026-09-05)

1. All 15 constituents MD5-verified against STAGING-MANIFEST.md immediately before assembly — all OK.
2. Assembly by direct page copy (no recompression, no resampling); 566 pages written.

3. On-mount MD5s of the three parts re-computed and matched to the local builds bit-exact.
4. Seam verification: 28 pages rendered and eyeballed (every divider, every unit head, every part-terminal page) — all correct, including the boundary witnesses (Mawwāq print 3 headword; Zurqānī print 170 waqf running head; Kharashī print 101 gloss opening; Dasūqī footer ١١; ‘Illīsh footer ٢٠٥).
5. Pixel-fidelity sample: three page-pairs (Part 1 p. 5 vs. Mudawwana extract p. 4; Part 2 p. 119 vs. Burzulī v05 section p. 1; Part 3 p. 81 vs. Zurqānī container p. 170) — **pixel-identical, maxdiff 0** on all three.

3.3 C.3 Builds-of-record note

The single-file build (155,680,830 B) exists only as a local staging artifact; it was never delivered (the 100 MiB ceiling) and is superseded by the three parts of record (§C.1), which are its exact page-for-page equivalent. The truncated 100 MiB carcass left by the failed write was destroyed of record on this date.

§D. Errata Cross-References

- **E-1 (to HIBAH-VOLUME-FIRST-EDITION-R1-2026-09-05 certificate §4):** Mawwāq span statement corrected — ḥiba print 3~36; laqṭa running heads from print 37. Pins used (print 3; print 24) inside the true span.
